Draeger flashing gauge and whistle meets NFPA 1981, 1997 edition

The new Draeger Safety, Inc. flashing gauge and whistle is fully compliant to and approved under NFPA 1981, 1997 edition as well as NIOSH. The new flashing gauge incorporates the non-aspirating whistle as the audible low-pressure alarm. Additionally two red LED strobe lights are used as a visual, independent redundant low pressure alarm. Both the audible and visual low-pressure alarms activate when the air in the cylinder is reduced to 25%. The strobe LEDs are easily visible by the wearer with no need to hold. The flashing gauge and whistle comes standard on all Draeger NFPA compliant SCBAs without the AirBoss Sentinel. When the flashing gauge is used in conjunction with the Super IPASS II, the Draeger SCBA is fully compliant to NIOSH and both NFPA 1981, 1997 edition and NFPA 1982, 1998 edition.

The flashing gauge and whistle assembly:

- Is fully compliant to NIOSH and NFPA 1981, 1997 edition
- Includes both an audible and visual low pressure alarm in the form of a non-aspirating whistle
- Includes an independent, visual low pressure alarm using two red strobe lights
- Can upgrade any AirBoss Evolution or AirBoss PSS100 currently using a non-flashing gauge
- When used in combination with the Super IPASS II, makes the SCBA compliant to both NFPA 1981, 1997 edition and NFPA 1982, 1998 edition, as well as NIOSH
